



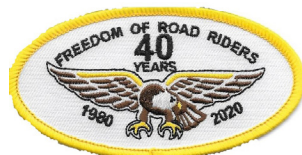

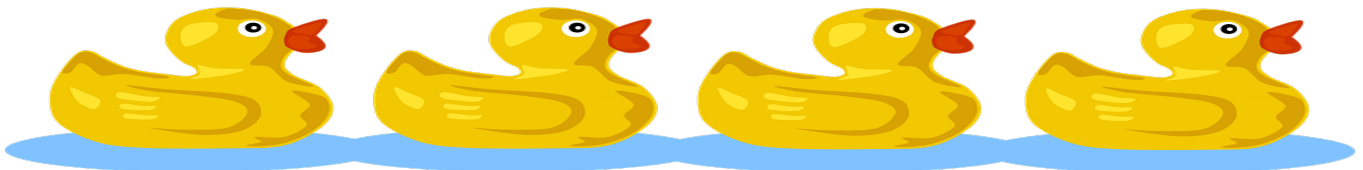

Motorcycle Safety – Beth Livingston

The site audit went very well. The grading was very positive. Need daytime coaches. There is new location in the bootheel. Need at least 1 coach and a place to store the bikes. To have a range in Trenton, help from the locals in that area would be helpful. There aren't any course sites in the bootheel or northern Missouri. If a new location isn't open, there will be motorcycles for sale. Missouri state is requiring the safety bikes must have turn signals and rearview mirrors. If one is to get broken, it must be fixed immediately. Range aids haven't had a pay increase in 10 years. There is only 1 ARC training coach in Mid-Missouri. <A motion was made by L1 and 2nd by L28 to raise the cost of the safety course by \$25. Motion passed by unanimous voice vote with little discussion.> <A motion was made by L1 and 2nd by L11 to allow a riders ed student to join FORR within 30 days of taking the course. They will only receive the electronic Freedom Press. Motion passed by unanimous voice vote with no discussion.>

Greetings Riders, Mea Culpa about last month's newsletter. I started it early figuring I could add to it until time to send it and then forgot to send. There really wasn't a lot in it. As you know, our scheduled rides are over for the year. Winter is almost upon us and, by the time you get this, will be officially here.

November was a mixed bag as riding goes. We had some nice days, some cold days and some days with snow and ice. Amazing how it can be in the high 60's and perfect riding weather on one day and have snow the next, but that's Missouri weather. Ice and snow and motorcycles are a bad combination, so it is about the end of this year's riding season. It may be already over for some of you.

Soon it will be a new year and we'll be dealing with PMS (Parked Motorcycle Syndrome) until spring arrives. Now is the time of year to order in your new tires for next season. The local shops will probably be available to mount them for you with very little waiting. It's also time to winterize the bike, if you haven't already. Change the oil so that it doesn't sit for a while with dirt oil and the corrosives it will accumulate. Put fuel stabilizer in the tank and run it long enough to get it into the carbs or to coat the injectors. Do any maintenance that you put off because the weather was too nice. Put your battery on a tender or at least give it a boost at least once a month. If it is over 3 years old, it might be time to think about a replacement come spring. Besides the bike, it is also a good time to check your gear for the next season. Rub conditioner into your leathers, inspect the zippers for wear, and check the seams of all your jackets and other clothes for weak areas that could split the next time you wear them.

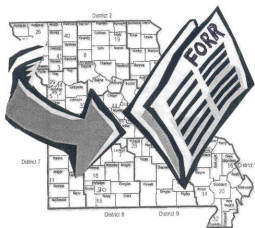
ARE YOU READY FOR THE 2020 LEGISLATIVE SESSION?

This is the question you need to ask yourself soon. This year is also an election year and things have already started with pre-filing legislation on December 1st. As of this writing we have a few bills pre-filed and checking on what other legislation has been filed. Here is a list of the bills that we will be following; SB 590 (Sen. Burlison) Helmet modification, SB 532 (Sen. Wallingford) Texting and driving (use of handheld devices), HB 726 (Rep. Hicks) shoulder use bill, HB 1204 (Rep. Hicks) grass clippings/debris on road. For now, this is all and I am sure there will be other legislation to come along in the first few weeks of session. As more information comes to light, I will do my best to keep you informed.

Some dates of interest for this session are as follows: January 8th First day of session; January 20th MLK, Jr. Day; March 23-27 Legislative spring break; April 13th Easter Break and May 15th last day of session. Also, the Mike Sloan Memorial MAY Rally will be April 28th. I will try and schedule each Local a day to come to the Capitol throughout this session and hopefully through the first part of session because that is the time when your help is most needed. I will have the list ready at the January Central Committee meeting.

As stated already it is a Presidential election year and we need to be prepared to help with campaigns or just be informed on who is running and if they support us or not. Some legislators will be terming out next year and others will be seeking reelection. All the statewide offices will be up for grabs, all state representatives and odd numbered senate districts also up for election this year. If you know of a candidate that we, as an organization, ought to support please let me know or just keep your local informed and help candidates any way you can, they always appreciate your help. All US Representatives will be up for reelection and one-third of the US Senate; however, we won't have a US Senate election until 2022. So please get out and help these potential candidates that you support or at least keep an informed position and get out and vote this year. Thank you all and I hope everyone had a wonderful Christmas and a Happy New Year.
